THE ANTI-WORKER NLRB SHOULD BE CLOSED FOR RENOVATIONS

The Bush-appointed National Labor Relations Board has launched an all-out attack on America's workers. The board's contempt for workers peaked in September, when it issued more than 60 decisions mostly attacking workers' freedom to form unions.

The NLRB is supposed to protect our workplace rights—not take them away. The board was created to encourage workers to have unions and bargain collectively to improve lives and build a strong middle class.

But the board appointed by President Bush is worse than having no labor board at all.
